
Parenting Survey


Term 2 - 2019-20

The objective of the survey was to understand the opinions, attitudes, perceptions, and point of views of parents related to their parenting habits.


1. I am responsive to my child's needs and feelings.




2. I take my child's wishes into consideration before I ask him/her to do something.




3. I encourage my child to talk about his/her feelings and problems.




4. I encourage my child to freely "speak his/her mind", even if he/she disagrees with me.




5. I provide comfort and understanding when my child is upset.




6. I compliment my child.




7. I consider my child's preferences when I make plans for the family (e.g., weekends away and holidays).




8. I respect my child's opinion and encourage him/her to express them.




9. I treat my child as an equal member of the family:




10. I provide my child reasons for the expectations I have for him/her.




11. I spend family times together with my child.




12. When my child asks me why he/she must do something I tell him/her it is because I said so, I am your parent, or because that is what I want.




13. I punish my child by taking privileges away from him/her (e.g., TV, games, visiting friends).




14. I raise my voice when I disapprove of my child's behaviour:




15. I use criticism to make my child improve his/her behaviour:




16. I punish my child by withholding emotional expressions (e.g., kisses and cuddles).




17. I find myself struggling to try to change how my child thinks or feels about things.
